Rules 3, 4 and 5 of the Rules of the Chancery Bar Association provide:

*3. There shall be three classes of member, namely full members, associate members and honorary members.*

*4. The following persons in practice at the Bar of England and Wales shall be eligible for full membership of the ChBA:-*

*(1) barristers in independent practice whose practice consists primarily of Chancery work.*

*(2) barristers in independent practice who are tenants in Chambers and intend and are likely to develop a practice consisting primarily of Chancery work.*

*Chancery work shall mean work of a type which, when undertaken in the High Court, is suitable to be undertaken in the Chancery Division.*

*5. Employed barristers who have been called to the Bar of England & Wales and whose work consists primarily of Chancery work shall be eligible for associate membership of the ChBA.*
