SCHOLARSHIPS

Open to members of all Inns

Pegasus Scholarships (up to 5 years' practice):

- Bermuda – 6 months at a commercial law firm
- India – up to 8 weeks in criminal, human rights or public interest law
- Australia – 3 months working with the Chief Justice of the Family Court of Australia;
- Dubai – 3 months split between a commercial law firm and the DIFC courts
- Hong Kong – time marshalling for a High Court Judge, working with barristers and working with a law firm
- New Zealand – 3 months with a law firm/ the Crown Law Office/ chambers
- Singapore – up to 3 months in a commercial law firm
- ECHR – up to 3 months
- USA (Washington D.C.) – 6 weeks.

- 1 month (September) in Paris undertaking a stage in an *Avocat's* offices, attending hearings, visiting the *Palais de Justice*, an administrative tribunal or the *Conseil d'Etat* with and conducting a mock trial in the *Palais de Justice*.
