The placements are governed by the terms of the [Framework Agreement](#) entered into by the above Associations in May 2014. Student's attention is particularly drawn to paragraphs 10 to 23 (inclusive).

Cayman articulated clerks may apply to up to 3 sets of chambers for a 12 week placement. Each application should be completed on a separate form and all forms returned, completed and scanned, by e-mail to admin@chba.org.uk. Forms must be received by 5pm (GMT) on Friday 16 December 2019. Applicants are also asked to complete and send in with their application(s) a Diversity Monitoring Form though this is not compulsory.

Offers by Chambers will be made by 5pm (GMT) on 10 January 2020 and must remain open for acceptance until 5pm (GMT) on 24 January 2020.

Acceptances must be notified to Chambers and the ChBA by 5pm (GMT) on 24 January 2020. If necessary, a clearing process will then operate to try to match any unsuccessful applicants with Chambers.

Any acceptances under the Scheme will be subject to the agreement of the ChBA and the Legal Advisory Council of the Cayman Islands.
